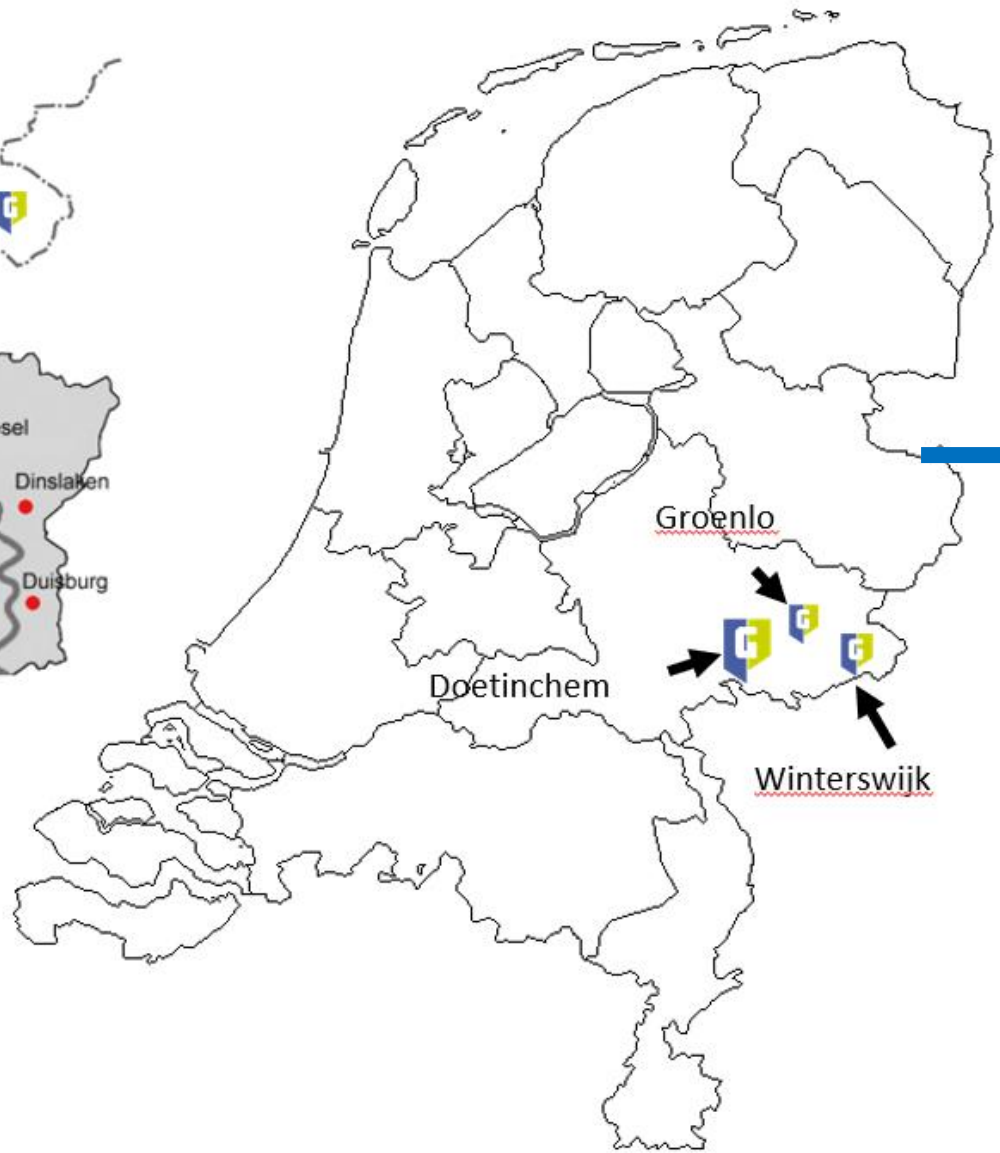
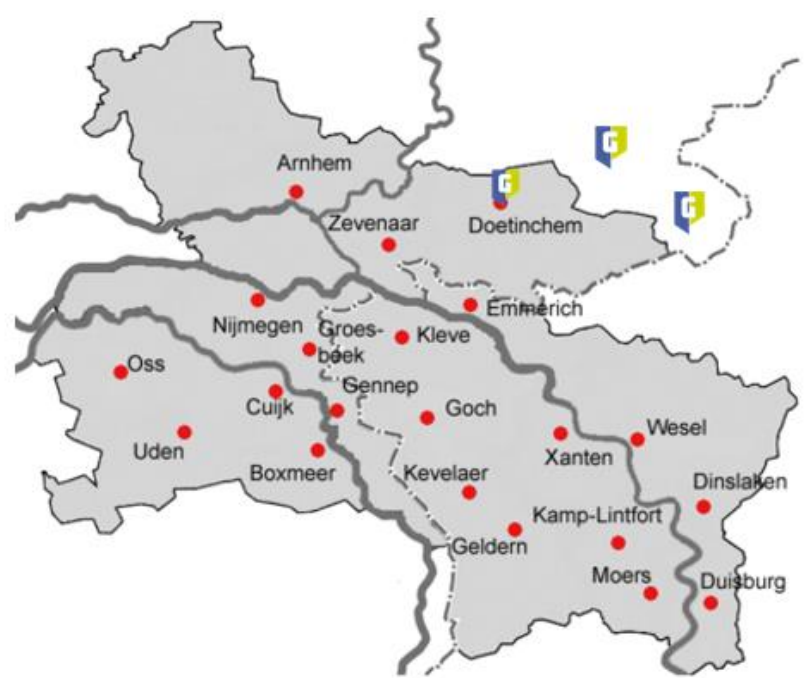

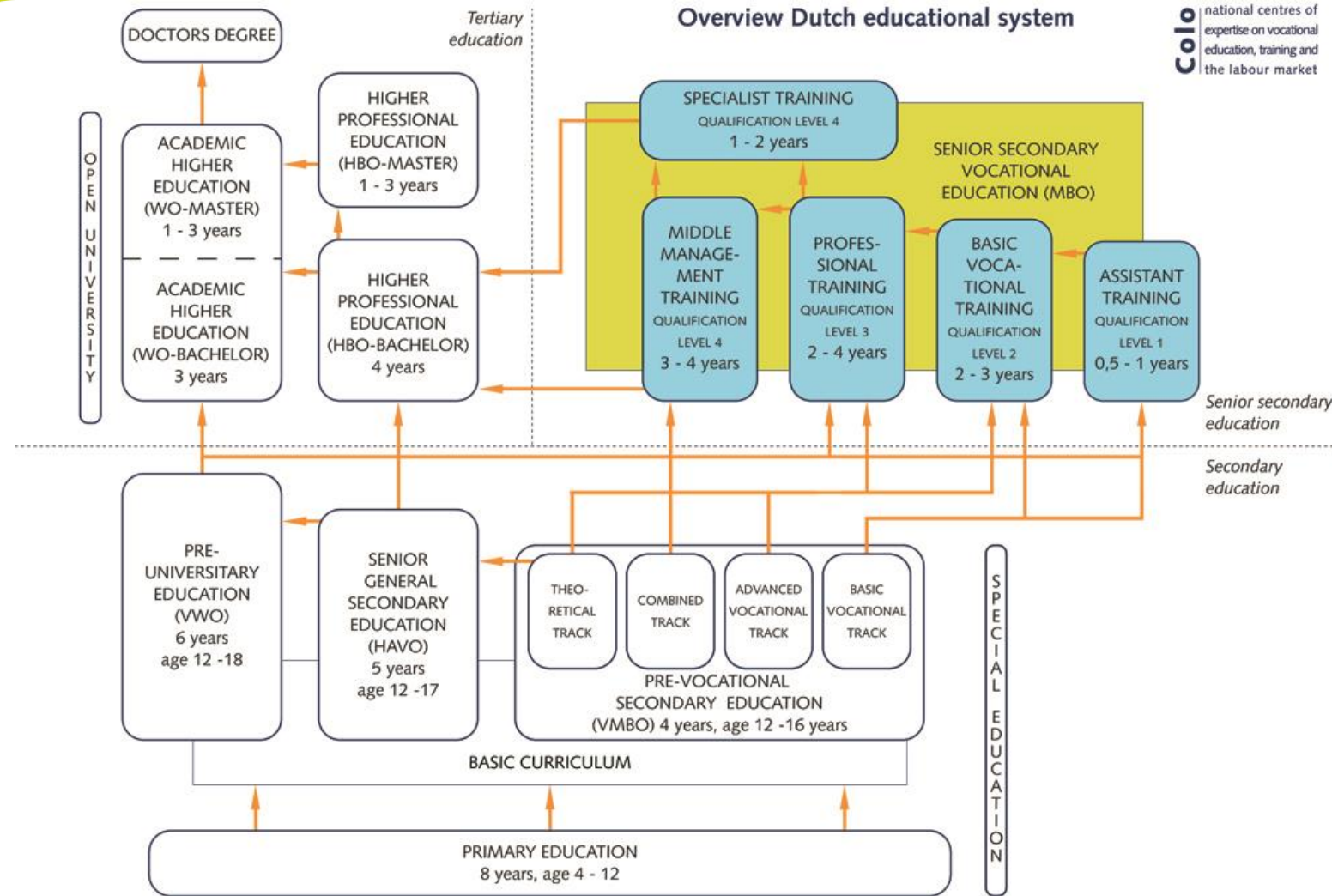

- 9000 students
- The vocational education has 4 levels, between basic and middle educated
- After level 4 you can go to the university of applied sciences
- 14 locations
- 4 different departments in vocational education and training
- Successrate about 85% (8% above national average)
- Drop outs 7,6 %

Education learning routes

Three learning routes:

- **School-based route(bol)**

Around 75% of studying time at school and 25% of studying time in practice in a company

- **Work-based route(bbl)**

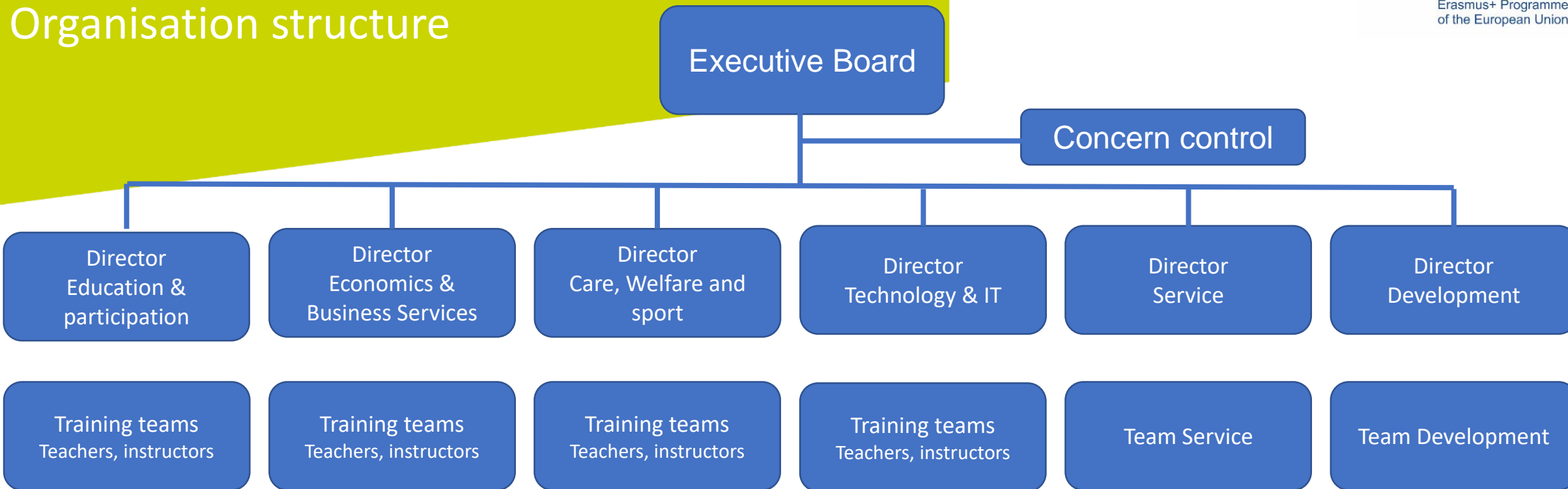
Combination of working and learning; around 25% at school and 75% as an employee in a company

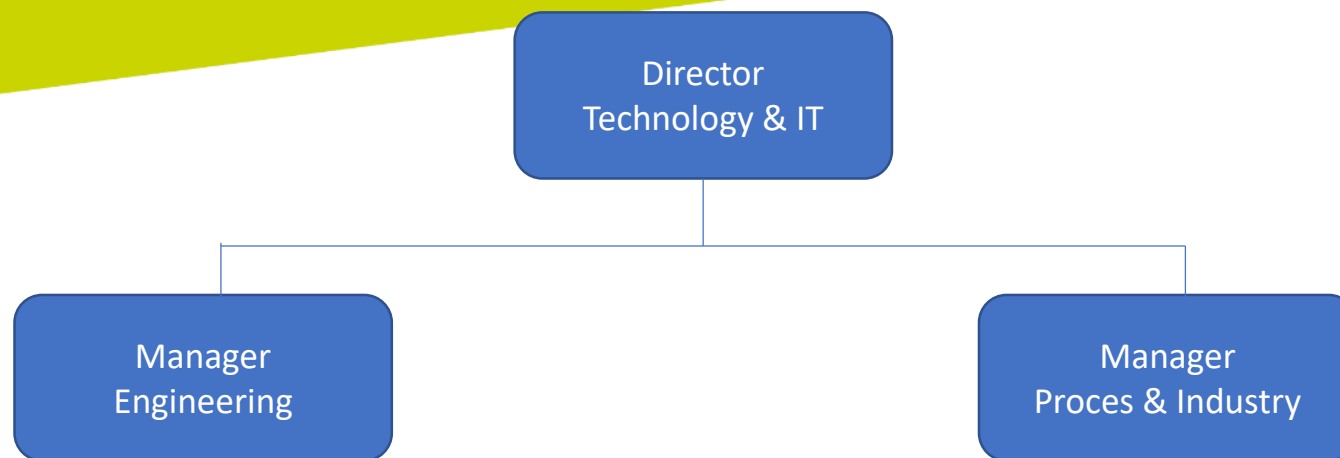
